PostCom has a very active Educational Committee that strives to ensure that members have access to vital informational tools. Here are just some of the educational resources that are available to all PostCom members.

- [PostCom Web Site News Page](#) (postal news from around the nation and the world that's updated continuously)
- [PostCom Bulletin](#) (published weekly and considered the most comprehensive and timely source of national and international postal news. It's considered must reading by Members of Congress, congressional staffs, Postal Regulatory Commissioners, the Postmaster General, all USPS officers, and by postal officials at all other levels. The PostCom Bulletin serves not only as a source of postal news, but also as a shaper of postal opinion. Indeed, it's widely considered the "most influential" postal newsletter in the nation.)
- [PostCom Postal Podcasts](#) (an audio review, recorded in an easy to listen to .mp3 format, that features experts on various postal topics discussing key issues and postal programs)
- [PostCom PostOps Updates](#) (a special publication summary of all the news on latest postal operational programs and changes, including information shared exclusively at meetings of the Postmaster General's Mailers Technical Advisory Committee-- MTAC)
- [PostCom Postal Policy Issues Briefs](#) (straightforward reviews of the latest developments concerning postal legislation, other aspects affecting the nation's postal policies and the provision of postal services)
- [PostCom Postal Operations Library](#) provides PostCom members with a tool to obtain the most comprehensive information available on a particular issue on postal operations topics.
- **PostCom Postal Webinars.** This online service offers PostCom members with a cost-efficient way to get the benefits of attending a postal conference without any of the expense. Webinars are planned and conducted on an as-needed basis on topics that are deemed of value to PostCom members.

In addition, PostCom also is the founder of a new online publication called the [Postal Journal](#). This will be a place for discussion of a variety of issues and ideas pertaining to the re-engineering of the nation's postal system to better meet the nation's needs in the years ahead.

There's also a weekly podcast called [This Week In Postal](#), which is hosted and produced by PostCom with the participation of other key players in the postal community. It's informative, it's entertaining, it's a bit irreverent, but it's always on target.
